# NEW CUMBERLAND OLDE TOWNE FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION 2024

The NEW CUMBERLAND OLDE TOWNE FOUNDATION is administrated by a Board of Trustees elected from the NEW CUMBERLAND OLDE TOWNE ASSOCIATION. The scholarship committee is appointed by this Board to select the recipients of the scholarships. The scholarships will be presented to selected students from Cedar Cliff, Red Land and Trinity High Schools and one student from area private schools/home schooled.

The applicant must have been accepted for admission to an accredited college/university/school that offers a two (2) or four (4) year degree/certificate program.

The applicant must attach a picture to the application that may be used for publicity purposes and will not be returned.

The scholarships will be publicized through official publications of the New Cumberland Olde Towne Association, local media and through guidance counselors at each of the high schools.

One scholarship payment in the amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) and one scholarship payment in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) will be made directly to the college/university/school in which the recipients are enrolled. In the event the enrollment is not completed or the applicant withdraws before the end of the first year, the institution will be directed to return the funds to the Foundation.

# NEW CUMBERLAND OLDE TOWNE FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION 2024

Deadline – Applications must be postmarked by the school counselor no later than April 5, 2024. Application should be submitted to the senior guidance counselor at your school. Winners will be selected by the committee appointed by the NEW CUMBERLAND OLDE TOWNE FOUNDATION BOARD OF TRUSTEES by April 15, 2024 and student will be notified at the Awards Ceremony at each school.

Scholarships – The basis for these awards shall be academics, leadership, and community service. Preference will be given to a student that lives within the Borough of New Cumberland. One award will be in the amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) and one award will be in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).

In addition to this application, applicants must submit the following information attached to the application. Note: Incomplete applications and attachments will NOT be considered.

- 1. A high school transcript including the first two marking periods of the senior year.
- 2. A letter of recommendation from the guidance counselor written on high school stationery.
- 3. A letter of acceptance from the college/university/school that they will be attending.
- 4. A list of school activities participated in by the applicant, offices held and honors received.
- 5. A listing, with short description, of experiences of community service.
